A Meaningful New Name

The building will be renamed **PEP Chesnutt** in honor of prominent 20th century Cleveland **Charles Waddell Chesnutt** who once lived on the land now occupied by the building. Chesnutt has been called "The pioneer of the color line" and was an author, crusader for racial and social justice, humanitarian, and forerunner to the Harlem Renaissance. In 1899 he was the first person of acknowledged African descent to be published by an established publisher of the day. He was a teacher, school principal, operated a successful court reporting business, passed the Ohio Bar in 1887 with the highest score, championed the cause of equal rights for all people without regard to caste or color, and published six books. In 1928 he was awarded the prestigious Spingarn Medal by the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People – an honor given once a year and one he shares with the likes of George Washington Carver, Mary McLeod Bethune, Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Langston Hughes, Rosa Parks, Oprah Winfrey and Congressman John Lewis.

SPACIOUS BRIGHT CLASSROOMS
