Classrooms at **PEP'S FIVE DAY TREATMENT CENTERS** are led by teams of educators and mental health professionals who weave hands-on academics, therapeutic interventions and social-emotional skill development into cohesive growth plans for every child. DTCs serves grades K-12, ages 5-22.

PEP CONNECTIONS

serves as a Care Management Entity (CME) for OhioRISE, and in this role provides intensive and moderate care coordination for multi-system involved youth in the region known as Catchment Q, which includes most of Cleveland and its inner-ring eastside suburbs. In addition, PEP **CONNECTIONS** also delivers Intensive Home-Based Treatment (IHBT) to anyone in Cuyahoga County.

PEP PRENTISS AUTISM CENTER

Through a strength-based model of instruction and consultation, PEP helps young people with autism discover new ways of relating and communicating with the world around them. PEP has worked extensively with children with autism and their families since the mid-1980s - long before it became a highprofile diagnosis. PEP PRENTISS' programming is designed around the specific needs and hopes of each child and family.

partner with educators and other professionals who work with children to assess their unique situations and develop actionable plans for success — whether for an individual student, classroom, entire school district or child-serving organization. Trainings for peer professionals are offered throughout the year as well.
