## WHY PEP?



#### WHOLE CLASSROOM SUPPORT

Time Frame: 3 Months

Our experts from PEP Assist support the whole classroom, working with teachers to implement best-practice strategies that promote student engagement and active participation. Consultation services include strategies to embed social emotional wellbeing in learning activities and a whole classroom Neurosequential Model of Education<sup>TM</sup> (NME) Functional Map. Time Frame: 6 Months
